REGARDING INTERNET REGISTRATIONS

2. Each registrant will receive a user name and password for access. Registrants will be able to change their user names and passwords and manage their accounts.

4. Only one user (per user name and password) may view or access archived conference. It is not permissible to share user name and password with third parties.
